The Visual, Performing and Communication Arts Program provides unique opportunities for the committed and talented student who has a serious interest in the arts. In-depth study of the arts develops conceptual and technical skills of artistic expression and brings to fruition the student's individual interpretations of the world. The arts training is provided by highly trained art teachers as well as professionals and working artists-in-residence. Students participate in extensive highly specialized courses in dance, music, theater, visual arts, communication arts, as well as a full academic program. **All students applying to these programs must meet the following eligibility criteria: 2.0 GPA plus an eligible audition score, if required.**
